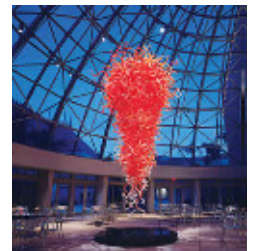
Spouse Welcome Breakfast

Floral Design

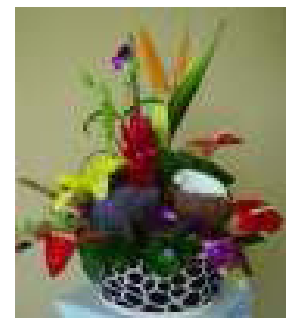
Monday, February 22, 3:00 – 5:00 pm
