ELIGIBILITY:

Corporations, partnerships, sole proprietorships and government agencies with offices in North America that are engineering firms, or provide engineering services, or are end-users of pumps may participate as a “Hydraulic Institute Standards Partner.” To be eligible the organization or individual must meet either of the following two criteria:

1. Must provide pump and pumping system engineering, process, or facility design, procurement, project management, construction services, hydraulic or mechanical modeling, analytical methods, or laboratory or field-testing to a facility owner, government, or vendor.
2. Must be an end-user of pumps.

EXCLUSIONS:

Corporations which are eligible to join the Hydraulic Institute as Pump or Supplier OEMs, Systems Integrators and Software Companies (Associate Members) are not eligible to become HI Standards Partners.

REQUIREMENTS:

Upon application and payment of appropriate fees, applicants to become HI Standards Partners must:

1. Attest that they meet the intent of the Hydraulic Institute Standards in the design, specification, installation, maintenance and/or testing of pumps and pumping systems
2. Agree, upon acceptance of their application, to post the HI Standards Partner logo on their home page, corporate profile page, or association links page. The logo must be hot-linked to the HI Web site, www.Pumps.org. Any descriptive copy which the Partner chooses to post to accompany the logo must be supplied or approved by HI.

PARTICIPATION:

Any full-time employee of a Standards Partner company, with appropriate expertise, may be eligible to participate in HI standards or guidelines writing committees. Participation is limited to two (2) individuals from each organization. Each participant must complete a Technical Areas of Expertise Form available for download in the Membership > Non-member Participation > HI Standards Partners section of the HI Web site, www.Pumps.org. Participation for additional individuals at divisions, operating units and/or offices worldwide is available as a Corporate “Add-On.” Details and a downloadable Corporate Add-On Form are available in the Membership > Non-member Participation > HI Standards Partners section of www.Pumps.org.
